Exhibitors must provide stands, vases, plats etc. for their exhibits. The Committee will not be responsible for any loss or damage to exhibits. Prize money and trophies must be collected from the Horticultural Tent by 4.30pm. No prize money will be posted. After 4.30 claims for prize money will have to be made to the secretary, in writing, enclosing a stamped self-addressed envelope. Exhibitors place cards will not be posted but will be available in the tent at the time of staging.
