The Shire Horse Society is pleased to award a silver plated spoon for the Best Mare or Filly

Conditions of the Award are as follows:

1. A Spoon for the Best Mare or Filly exhibited in the Shire Classes whose owner shall have been a member of the Local Society for not less than six months previous to the date of entry of the show.
2. The winner of the Special Prize must be a member of the Shire Horse Society.
3. No animal to be eligible to take more than one Silver Spoon during any one year, the Royal and Shire Society Shows excepted.
4. The winning animal must be registered, or eligible for registration, in the Stud Book or Grade B Register.
5. The winning animal must be free from hereditary disease.
6. The Judge invited to officiate must be on the Society's Official Panel and has the right to withhold the award if an exhibit does not show sufficient merit.
7. The Council reserves the right in offering their Spoon Awards only to persons approved by the Shire Horse Society and subject to confirmation in the uncontrolled discretion of the Council.
8. **TIME LIMIT** Official Returns of Awards of Spoons must be completed by one month from the date of the show, otherwise such awards will become void.

The Daniel Thwaites Perpetual Challenge Trophy will be awarded to the exhibitor gaining most accumulated points in 6 Shire horse classes at : GREAT HAREWOOD; BURY; GOOSNARGH&LONGRIDGE; GREAT ECCLESTON; GARSTANG

The Trophy will be presented at Garstang Agricultural Show in August. The points will be allocated as follows: 1st - 5 points, 2nd - 4 points, 3rd - 3 points, 4th - 2 points, 5th - 1 point. Each exhibitor will be allowed a 5 point attendance allowance for exhibition in the above classes.

Six classes at Goosnargh & Longridge, namely: Colt, Gelding or Filly, 1 year old ; Gelding or Filly, 2 year old ; Gelding, 3 year old and upwards; Brood Mare (with own foal at foot-foal need not be shown) ; Colt Foal ; Filly Foal.

Prize Money for the competition is as follows:

1st-£100, 2nd-£75, 3rd-£50, 4th-£25
